March 13, 2010 – 1300 warning - Three up-down races

NOTICE OF REGATTA

Rules – PHRF and yacht club memberships are urged but not required. Obey latest of USCG, RRS, PHRF Class Rules in Sect. 7 and App. B for category 4 race (but radio may be replaced with cellphone), class rules for ODs, this NOR, the SI, changes ordered at entry or at L flag on water. After a general recall, RRS 29.2 applies (10-minute delay). RRS 44.2 is changed to one-turn penalty. Ignore RRS 77. Check-in isn't required. L flag over class flag hails only this class.

Entries – Keelboats (LOA>19') are invited. Enter at RBYC 1030-noon on raceday. Fee is \$15. Or, get NOR, SI, chart, entry form from RedondoBeachYachtClub.org and pass entry and \$15 in envelope at start line before 1300 hrs.

Classes, Flags, Warning Times and Handicaps –

PHRF-A: Area B **Buoy** Rating < 150, class flag **A**, warning at **1300** for Race #1

PHRF-B: Area B **Buoy** Rating > 149, class flag **B**, warning at **PHRF-A** start.

Nonspinnaker offset may be used but does not change your class. **MARINER:**

RLC Rating + Cruiser Benefits > 149, class flag **M**, warning at **PHRF-B** start.

The following types need at least 3 entries to be scored as a class: **MARINER**, **MAR-242** (start with **PHRF-B**) and **CAL-20** (start with **MARINER**).

Courses – Three one-hr up-down courses. The Sailing Instructions page (SI) has the courses. All races start at S spar unless predicted NW or SE winds call to start all at K spar. Race committee (cell phone 310-697-9419) will try to monitor Ch 78.

Protests - Notify RC at race finish. File at RBYC within 45 min. of the last finish.

Scores – Time-on-distance corrections. RRS Low Point System. No scores will be excluded from races completed. Ties will be broken applying RRS A7 and A8.

Hospitality RBYC is open 1030-noon and 1500+, Bar 1600+ (310-374-4838), Protest hearings ASAP, Trophies 1800, Lt Supper 1800 (\$2)

Parking – Free for RBYC guests after 1500 hrs. Park where gate attendant directs.
