RULES-Current PHRF and yacht club memberships are required in PHRF Classes.
All skippers obey latest of USCG, RRS(exc.77), this NOR, the SI, changes at entry
or under L flag. (L flag over class flag hails only that class.) All skippers also obey
PHRF Rules (Sect.7, Category 4 race, but radio may be replaced with cellphone).
OneDesigns also obey class rules. No free-flying headsails in Mariner class.

ENTRIES- Self-righting monohulls may enter. Fee is \$16. Get this notice, sailing
instructions, spar chart and entry form either from RedondoBeachYachtClub.org
(Email completed form to j.ellinwoo@gmail.com before noon Friday and pay
before or after racing.) or file entry at RBYC from 10:30 to noon on raceday.

START ORDER AT C SPAR, CLASSES, HANDICAPS, 1st WARNING-

- 1. PHRF-A.** Area B BUOY rating < 130, Code flag A, 1st warning at 1300 hrs.
- 2. PHRF-B.** Area B BUOY rating >= 130, Code flag B, 1st warning at 1305 hrs.
Optional nonspin offset doesn't affect class. Next 3 types need 3 entries for a class.
- 3. MARINER class.** Add cruiser adjustments, Code flag M, 1st warning at 1310 hrs
CAL 20 class (Start as if **MARINER**) & **MARTIN 242 class** (Start with **PHRF-B**)

COURSES- Both regattas will have two buoy races ≈ 75 min ea. (Cf. Sailing Instr.)
Both start at spar C. The first is windward-leeward using PHRF Buoy handicaps.
The second ends at the harbor entrance, so will use PHRF RLC handicaps. Boats
that retire without finishing must call the race committee on **310-376-2521**.

PROTESTS- Notify RC at finish and file in club office within 45 min of last finish.

TROPHIES- 1 for 1-4 entries, 2 for 5-8, etc. Sum of day's corrected times (PHRF
scoring) will be compared. Ties will be broken by comparing only the shorter race.
