



2012 Redondo Beach Series NOTICE OF SERIES of Six Saturday Yacht Races

FEBRUARY 4 – PALOS VERDES BLT – A Beat-Leeward-Triangle course from K to an inflatable and other buoys. The race starts at 1300 and lasts about 3 hrs. Fee \$16.

FEBRUARY 25 - JOHN WALTI MEMORIAL REGATTA – One BUOY race from/to C spar and one RLC race from C to the harbor. Race #1 starts at 1300 hrs. Fee \$16.

APRIL 7 – LIGHTHOUSE RACE – from K to an inflatable off Palos Verdes and return. The 3-hr race starts at 1300 hrs. Fee is \$16.

MAY 5 – 37 FATHOM RACE – from K to an inflatable in 37 fathoms and the R-10PV bell and return. The 3-hr race starts at 1300 hrs. Fee is \$16.

JULY 7 – QUEEN MARY REGATTA – Coastal race from S to San Pedro Bay. Distance about 22 nm. Race starts at noon. Fee is TBD.

AUGUST 18 – JOHN PARKER MEMORIAL – Uses an inflatable outside of F. Starts at S at 1300 hrs and lasts about 2.5 hrs (Music at RBYC) Fee is \$16.

CLASSES – PHRF-A (RLC rating < 130) and PHRF-B (RLC rating >= 130). If 3 enter, also MARINER (non-spinnakers rated < 300 with cruiser benefits), MARTIN 242, CAL 20.

RULES - All entrants shall obey PHRF SoCal Rules, Specifications (Category 4 race). VHF 16 is req'd. The current Racing Rules of Sailing apply, with 720-deg turns and 10-min general restart, but excluding Rules 35 and 77. The committee will use cell phone **310-376-2521**. PHRF-A and -B class entrants must be current members of PHRF SoCal, those in a MARINER class may not fly free-flying headsails and whisker pole <= 1.4J, and those in a one-design class must obey class rules.

SCORING – Series classes are those established in at least four races (three if any were abandoned or cancelled). Qualifying skippers are those who started in a series class in at least four races (three if any were abandoned or cancelled). After non-qualifiers are removed, the best four scores (three if any races were abandoned or cancelled) of each will be added and compared using RRS Low Point Scoring and RRS A9 and A9. Series trophies will be awarded in December (one if 1-4 in a series class, two if 5-7, etc). The class leader will be immortalized on the Redondo Beach Series Perpetual.
