

## 2010 LIGHTHOUSE RACE

Race 2 of the Redondo Beach Series and an ASMBYC Hi-Point Race  
Saturday, March 6, 2010

### NOTICE OF RACE and SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

**Rules** – Entrants in **PHRF-A,-B** shall be members of PHRF, use Std PHRF Rules, Specifications, Equipment for a Category 4 race, and Area RLC ratings. Any **MARINER** class entrants may not use free-flying headsails, whisker pole may not exceed 1.4J, but may add cruiser benefits if not included in base rating. In **One Design classes**, class rules and required safety equipment apply. **Rules applying to all boats** are: minimum of two able sailors; adequate anchor, chain and rode; either VHF marine channels 16 and 78 or cellphone; the Racing Rules of Sailing (except RRS 35, 77); rules in this NOR-SI, changes announced at entry, and any hailed under **L** flag. If they conflict, the latest governs.

**Entries** Monohull sailboats are invited (except non-PHRF-members w. Area RLC rating <150)  
Locals: enter at RBYC from 1030 to noon on race day. Fee is \$15. Others: visit [RedondoBeachYachtClub.org](http://RedondoBeachYachtClub.org) for entry form and chart. Have \$15 at start line by 1300.

**Classes** **PHRF-A**: class flag **A**, warning at 1300, start at **1305**, Area RLC Rating < 150.  
**PHRF-B**: class flag **B**, warning at 1305, start at **1310**, Area RLC Rating > 149.  
NS offset doesn't change your class. For a class, the next 3 types need 3 boats in starting area. **MARINER**: class flag **M**, warning at 1310, start at **1315**, cruiser handicap > 149,  
**CAL-20** (shall start with **MARINER**), and **MAR-242** (shall start with **PHRF-B**).

**Starts** Check-in is not required. **L** flag over class flag hails only that class. Do not cross the start line, between flagship (orange flag) and flag or **K** spar, after first **P** flag is raised until your **P** flag is raised. After a general recall (RRS 29.2), expect **I** flag (RRS 30.1).

**Courses** Course number will be displayed on a black banner. Below, **R<sup>10</sup>** is the PV Point bell.

Round marks portside unless subscript S. Committee is on [310-697-9419](tel:310-697-9419) and Channel 78.  
Nonspinnaker class(es) always, and others in very light winds, should be given Course 9.

**Finish** at **W** (white can in port entrance) when the flagship near the breakwater sees you behind W before 1700 (1<sup>st</sup> time limit). Others: record finish & report at RBYC by 1745. Later, DNF.

**Protests** – Hail flagship at finish. Have completed form in race office within 1 hr of your finish.

**Scores, Trophies** –Time on Distance. Awards per class: one if 1-4 starters; two if 5-7; 3 if 8-10.
