## **NOTICE OF RACE and SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Rules** Entrants in **PHRF-A,-B** shall be members of PHRF, use Std PHRF Rules, Specifications, Equipment for a Category 4 race, and Area RLC ratings. Any **MARINER** class entrants may not use free-flying headsails, whisker pole may not exceed 1.4J, but may add cruiser benefits if not included in base rating. In **One Design** classes, class rules and required safety equipment apply. **Rules applying to all boats** are: minimum of two able sailors; adequate anchor, chain and rode; either VHF marine channels 16 and 78 or cellphone; the Racing Rules of Sailing (except RRS 35, 77); rules in this NOR-SI, changes announced at entry, and any hailed under **L** flag. If they conflict, the latest governs.

**Entries** Monohull sailboats are invited (except non-PHRF-members w. Area RLC rating <150)  
Locals: enter at RBYC from 0930 to 1100 on race day. Fee is \$15. Others: visit [RedondoBeachYachtClub.org](http://RedondoBeachYachtClub.org) for entry form and chart. Have \$15 at start line by warning.

**Classes** **PHRF-B**: class flag **B**, warning at 1145, start at **1150**, Area RLC Rating > 149.

**PHRF-A**: class flag **A**, warning at 1200, start at **1205**, Area RLC Rating < 150.

NS offset doesn't change your class. For a class, the next 3 types need 3 boats in starting area. **MARINER**: class flag **M**, warning at 1130, start at **1135**, cruiser handicap > 149,

**CAL-20** (shall start with **MARINER**), and **MAR-242** (shall start with **PHRF-B**).

**Start** Check-in is not required. The unrestricted start line at **S** is between flagship's orange flag and a flag or **S** spar. After a general recall (Cf. RRS 29.2) expect **I** flag (Cf. RRS 30.1).

**Course** Round **Y-28** to port. It is a yellow waverider buoy at **N 33° 51.27, W 118° 37.98**. Record your time of rounding and identify the nearest boat. Round **35** to starboard. **35** is a yellow inflatable buoy at **N 33° 51.37, W 118° 31.14**. Record the time and nearest boat and report on cell\* or VHF Ch.78 to committee. Take harbor bell **G** to port. Distance to **W** is 23.1 nm.

**Finish** at **W** (white can in port entrance) when the flagship near the breakwater sees you behind W by 1900 (1<sup>st</sup> time limit). Others, record finish time and report at RBYC by 1945. Later, DNF

**Protests** – Hail flagship at finish. Have completed form in race office within 1 hr of your finish. Hearings will be at RBYC on Tuesday April 6 at approximately 2030 hrs.

**Scoring** –RLC rating due to long course. Time on Distance. Boats who sailed to **W** will be ranked first. Then others who sailed to **35** but not to **W** will submit their time at **35<sub>S</sub>** to be ranked. Finally those who rounded **Y-28** but not **35** will submit their time at **Y-28** to be ranked. Trophies (1 if 1-4 in class, 2 if 5-7, 3 if 8-10) will be awarded one hr after last finish in class
