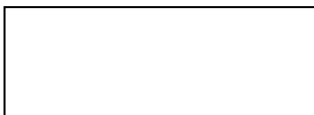

Every year we go into overdrive mode and get er done." This year was no exception.

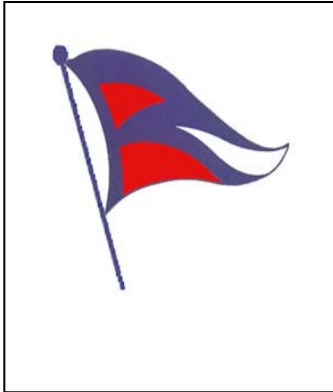
The cleaning crews worked hard both before and after to get the club in ship shape and the food was plentiful and delicious as always.
