

2021 Frank Guernsey Single-Handed Challenge Saturday, OCTOBER 16th, 2021 NOTICE OF RACE

Welcome to the Frank Guernsey Single-Handed Challenge. In this race, competitors must sail their vessel solo. The use of "autopilot or any other mechanical steering device" is prohibited. This is a demonstration of confidence, seamanship and determination to prevail against the other worthy sailors.

Entries – Sailboats with a PHRF Buoy Handicap of 280 or less are invited. One person on a sailing vessel. Life jacket required if boat lacks cockpit lifelines. Club or PHRF membership not required. Register; on www.redondobeachyachtclub.org entry form, or at RBYC clubhouse, from 1000 to 1130 on race day. Entry Fee is \$10.00.

Classes – Class splits will be determined using PHRF BUOY ratings. A: <135, B: 136-180, C: >180. Splits will be adjusted according to entries.

Race – One race will be sailed using the existing marks of King Harbor. Please see the current mark guide at www.khyc.org, www.redondobeachyachtclub.org.

Scoring - Boats will use their PHRF RLC Ratings, time on distance. (TOD)

Sailing Instructions – The sailing instructions will be available at; www.redondobeachyachtclub.org no later than 1900 on Friday, October 15th, 2021.

Starts- The start will be in the vicinity of "S" Mark. First warning at 1255.

Finish- The Finish Line is between orange flag on race committee boat and the Red "2" Nun Buoy located at the entrance of the harbor. "**W**" is a mark of the course.

Hospitality - Clubhouse Bar will be open at 1500.

Awards - Best overall corrected time will receive a trophy and their name engraved on the Frank Guernsey Perpetual Trophy.
